The library has **5 CCTV** cameras to keep a close watch on the users so as to minimize the losses and mutilation of reading material. Our college library is an institution within the institution. The young minds are exposed to ever-expanding fields of knowledge that lie dormant in books and journals. An endeavor is to make them library-minded. Ours is a functional, well-equipped, and fully computerized library having a proud collection of **48089 books** on its open shelves. In addition to this collection, the library also subscribes to e-resources which include e-journals and eBooks subscribed through the **DELNET Database, EBSCO Database, National Digital Library Database and other online free databases. Video Lectures through NPTEL** are also available for students. About 400 students and staff visit the library daily to read books, magazines, newspapers and to do their assignments.

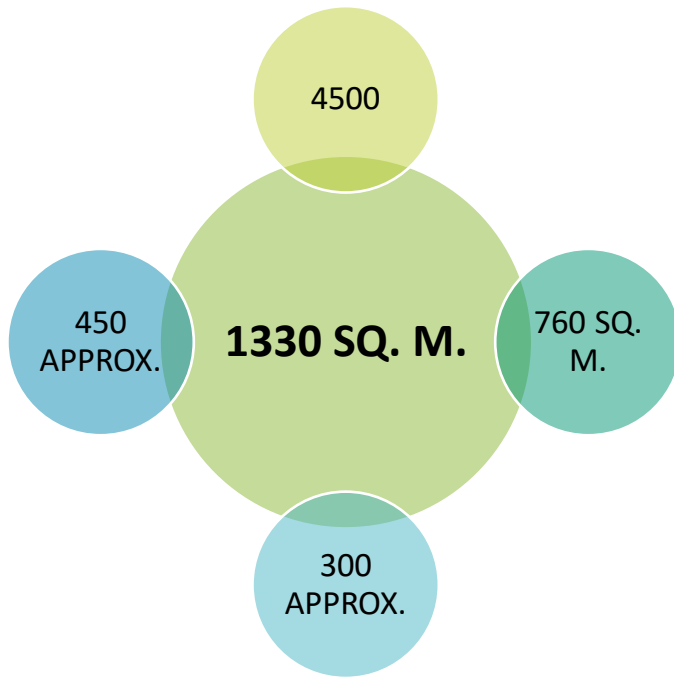

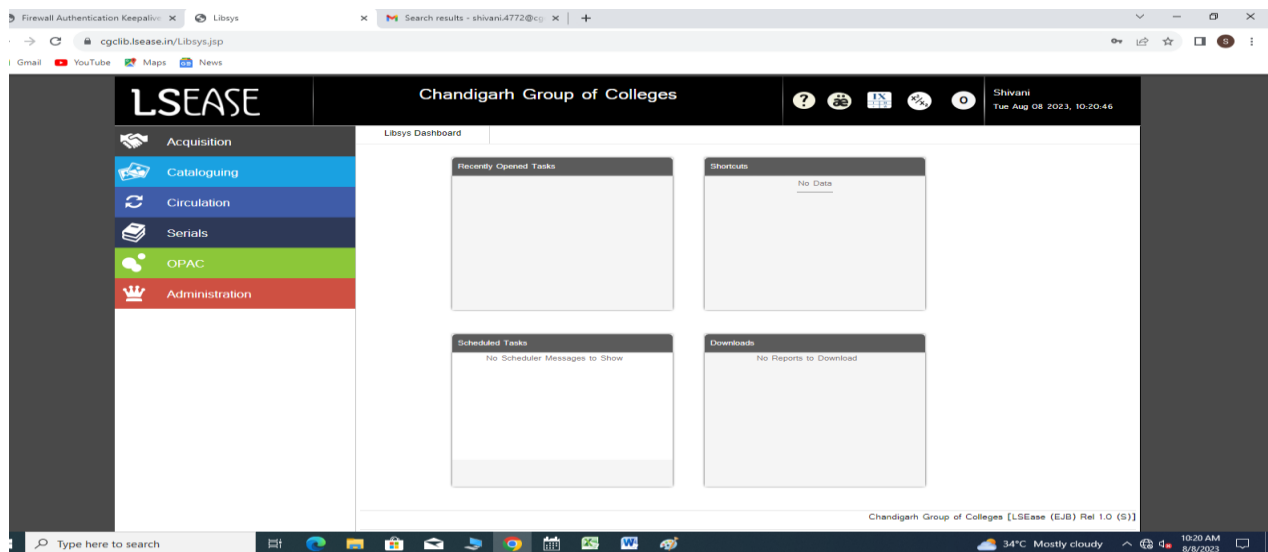

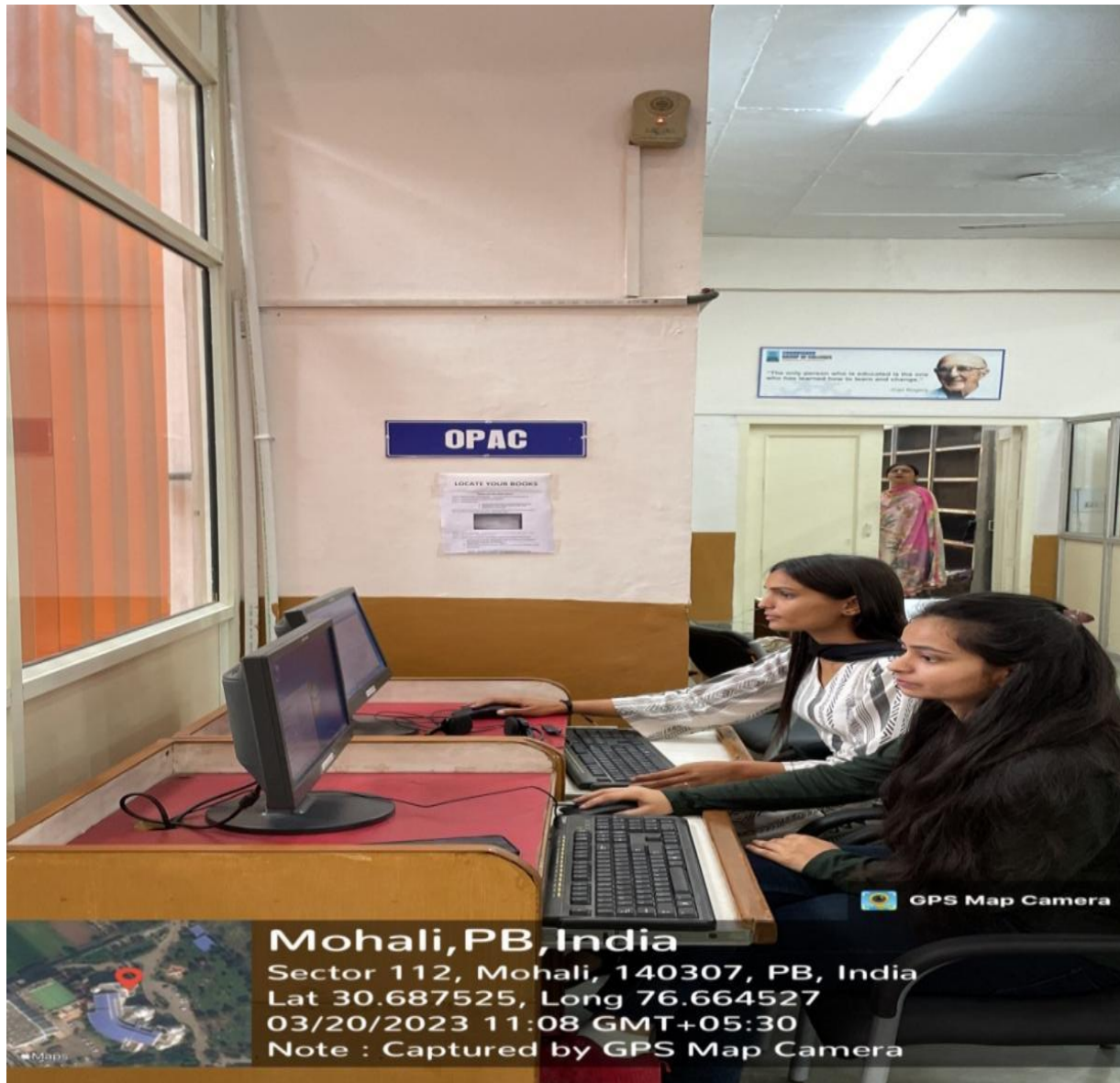


**BARCODE SCANNED ENTRY/EXIT:** Since the ID cards are scanned to keep track of entry and exit, foot traffic in the library is computerized. Students scan their ID cards as they enter or leave the library using the two barcode scanners that have been installed on the ENTRY/EXIT gate.

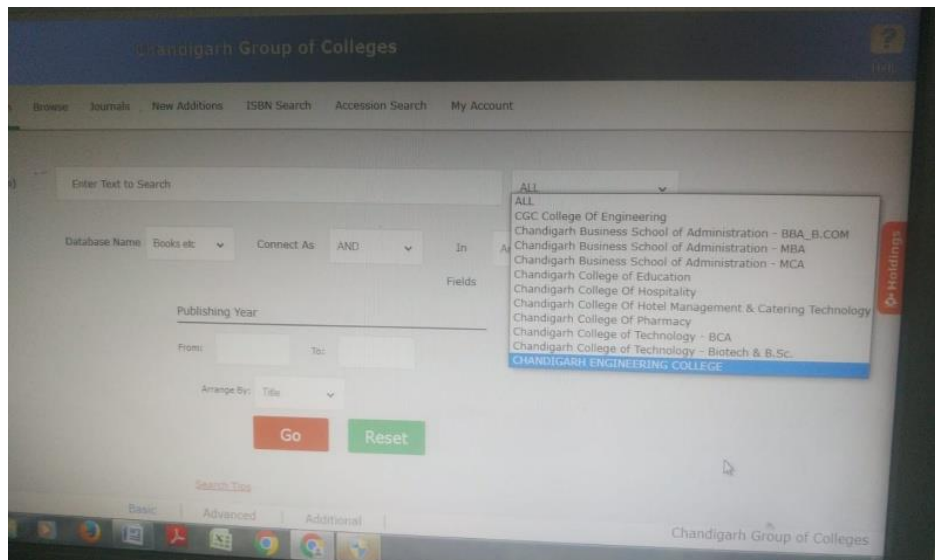

- **SEARCH BY TITLE (DON'T USE A, AN, THE)**
- **SEARCH BY KEYWORD**

**STEP 4 : SELECT THE BOOK OF YOUR CHOICE FROM YOUR CONCERNED LIBRARY ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE FIELD (i.e., ALL) AND “GO”.**



**STEP 5 : SELECT BROWSE : TO KNOW ABOUT COLLECTION BY AUTHOR , TITLE, CLASSIFIED, SUBJECT, PUBLISHER, PLACE.**

**STEP 6 : SELECT MY ACCOUNT : TO KNOW ABOUT THE BOOKS YOU HAVE**

- **FACULTY WILL ENTER EMPLOYEE CODE AS USER ID & STUDENTS WILL ENTER ROLL NO. AS USER ID.**
- **PASSWORD IS SAME FOR ALL “cgclib”.**

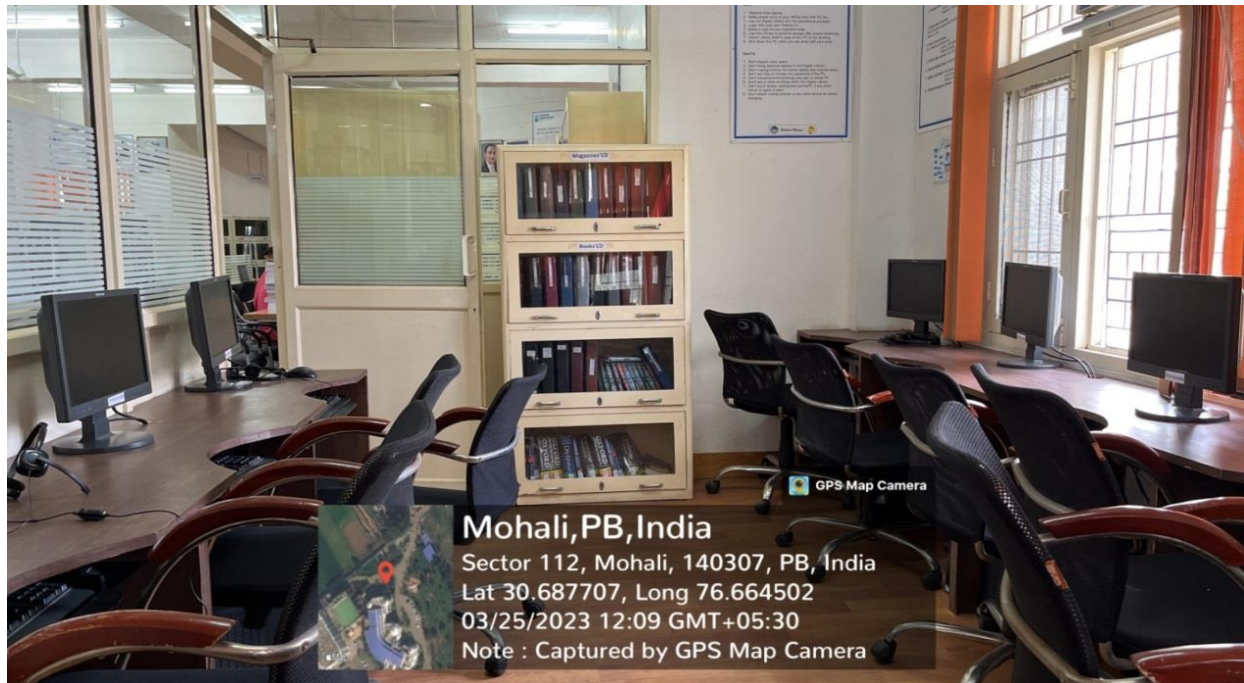

## 2021-22(ONLINE)

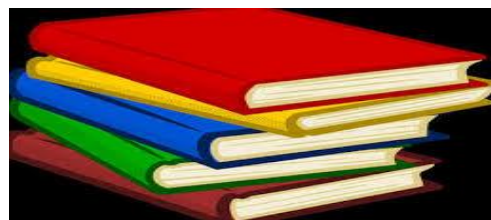

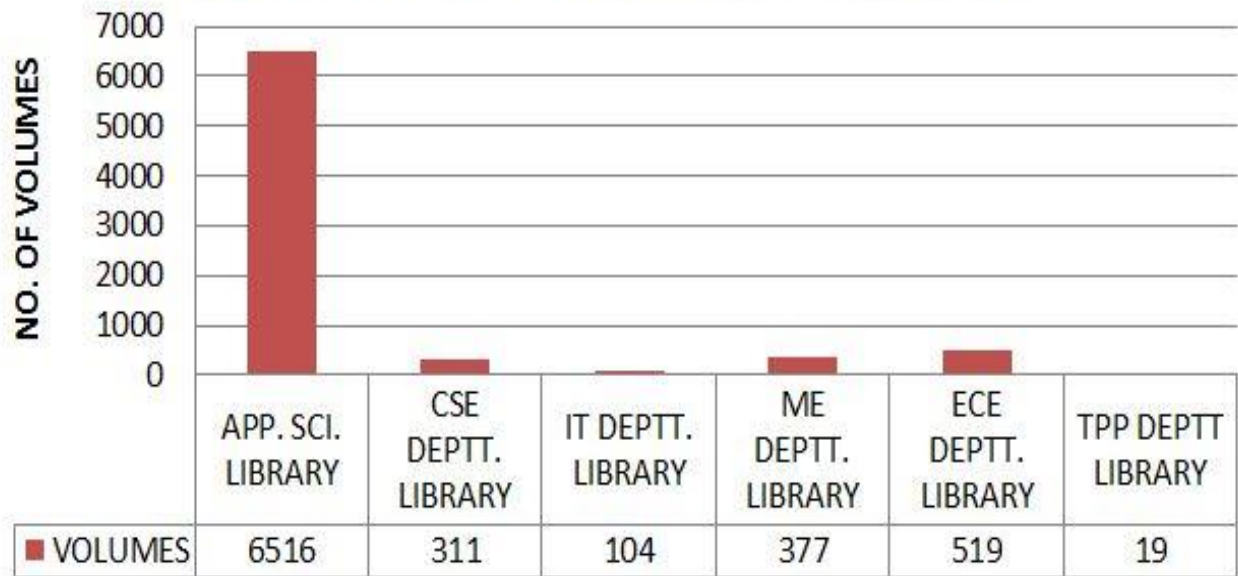

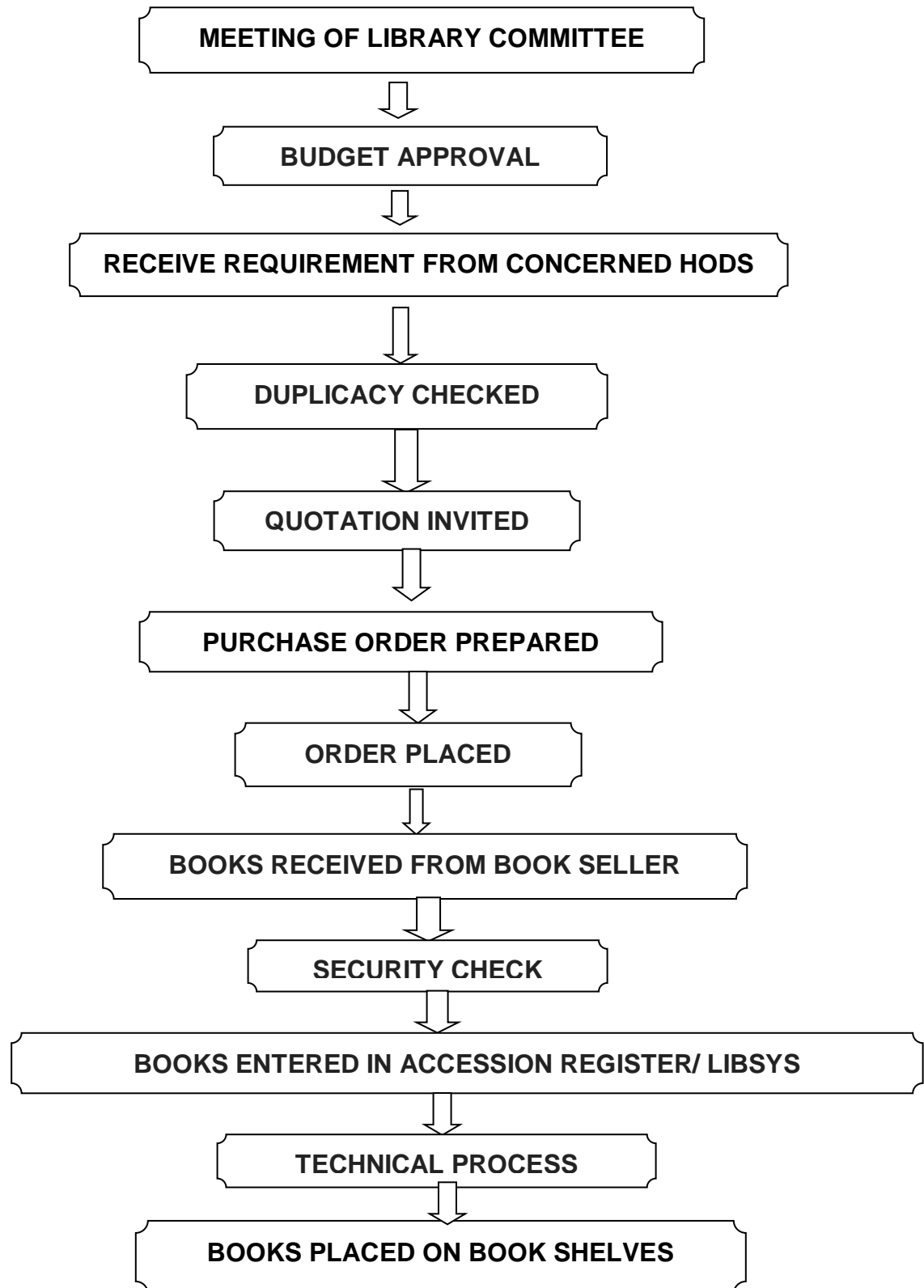

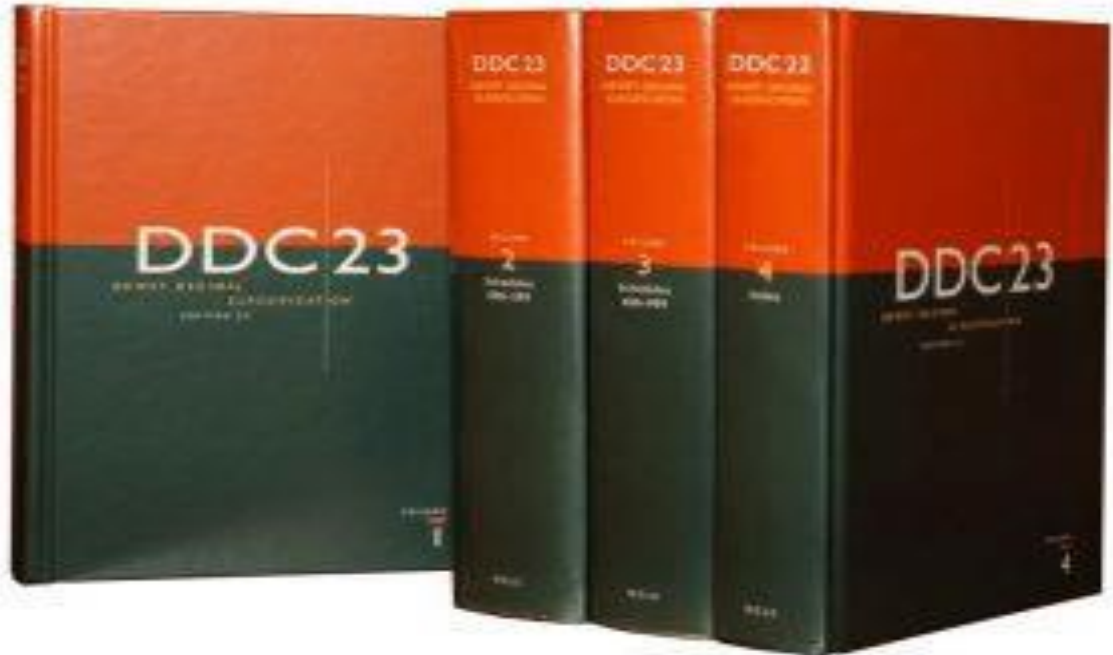

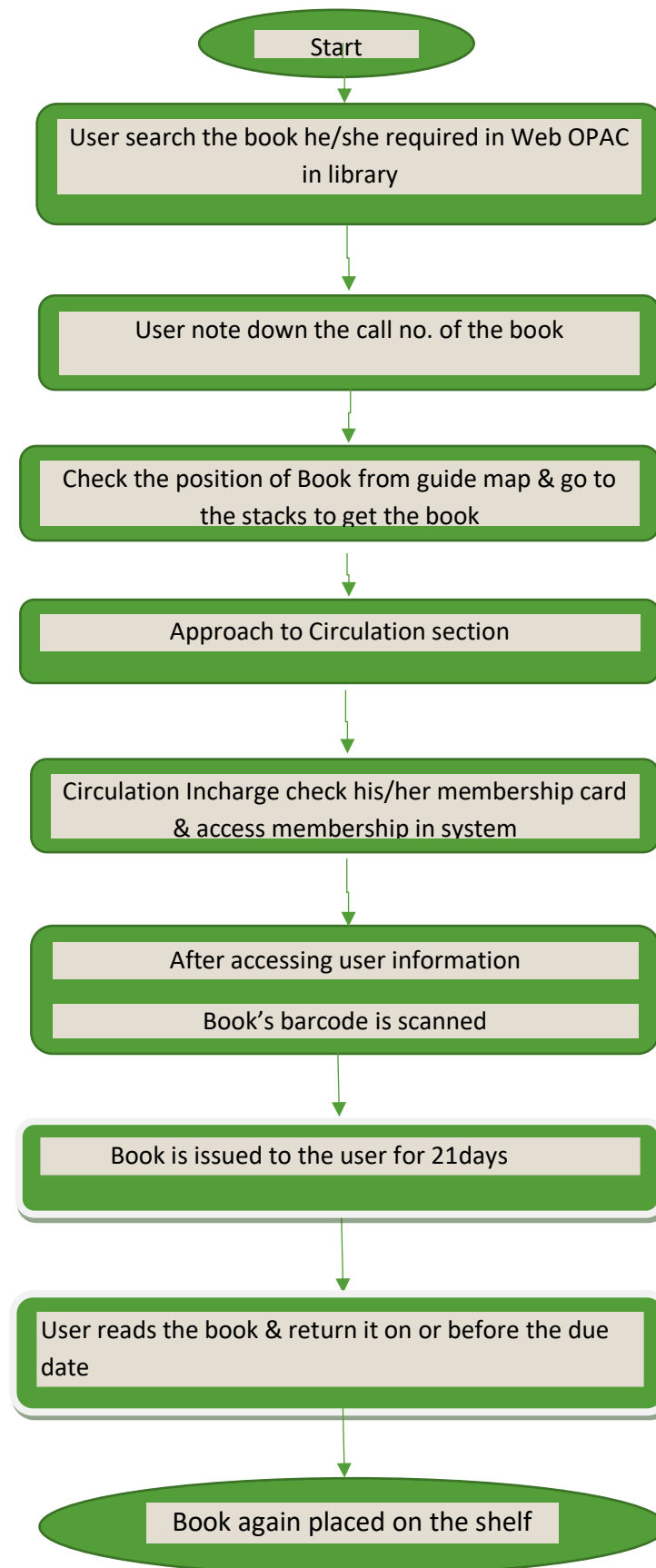

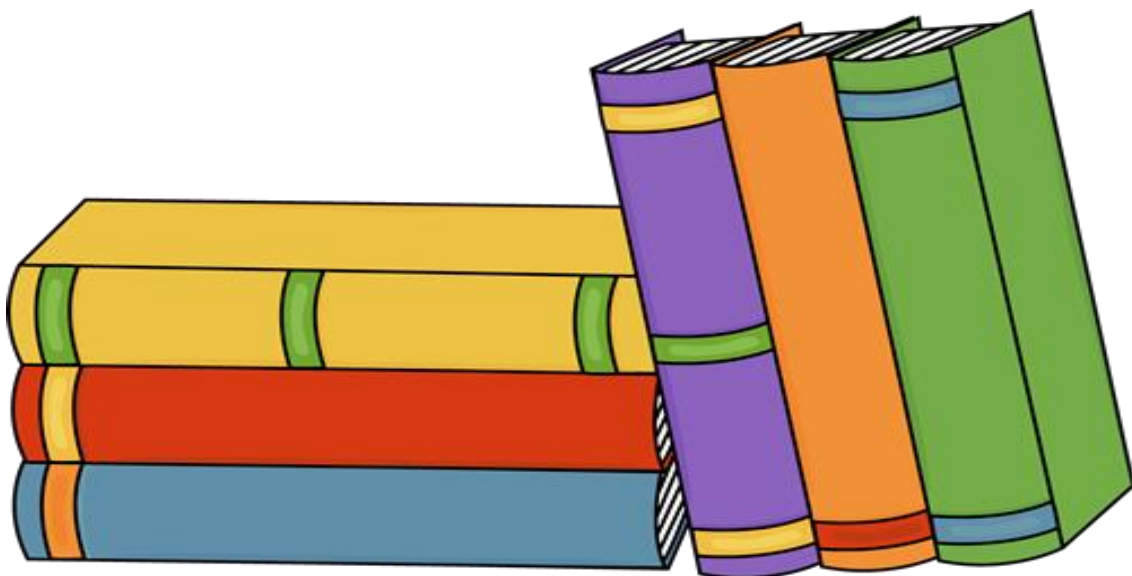
## LIBRARY RULES

- ✓ Each student is required to submit one stamp size photograph for use in the Lib/ID card.
- ✓ Make sure you have provided the correct email address and mobile number while filling your library membership form.
- ✓ This IDENTITY cum LIBRARY CARD is non-transferrable. In case of loss of Library Card, immediately report to the Library staff so that your membership is temporarily blocked to prevent misuse of the Library Card. Once you get a replacement, please inform circulation staff so that your membership can be re-activated.
- ✓ A Student should always carry this card on his person while in the library or in college. He should produce it on demand by the library staff/college staff.
- ✓ Number of books issued to a student of Graduate classes and Post Graduate classes is three and period of retention of books allowed in each case is 21days. Fine Re.2 per book per day will be charged



for the late return of books (after the due date) for first 14 days and thereafter Rs. 5/- per day per book will be charged as fine.

- ✓ Do not write, underline or mark any book. Library books are carefully examined on return and the borrower will be held responsible for the damage.
- ✓ Reference Books and Magazines are available for consultation only in the Library.
- ✓ Loss of the book should be immediately reported to the librarian and the matter settled by replacing the book or paying its prices within a week of due date. Delay fine, however, will be charged up to the date the matter is settled.
- ✓ The damage, if any, to a book should be brought to the notice of the librarian before getting the books issued, otherwise the person returning it will be held responsible for the damage.
- ✓ The student will be responsible for any loss which the library may suffer due to loss or misuse of the library/Id card.

- ✓ Ask for help from library staff if you are unable to find your required material

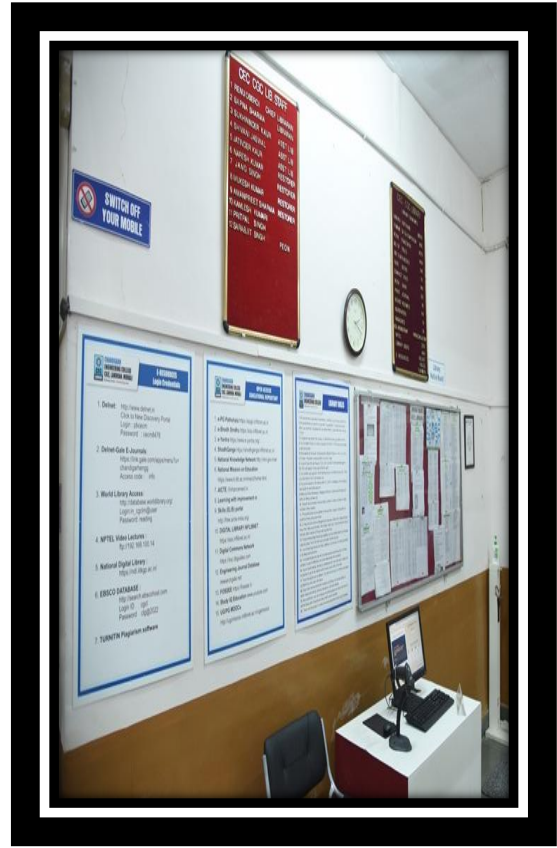




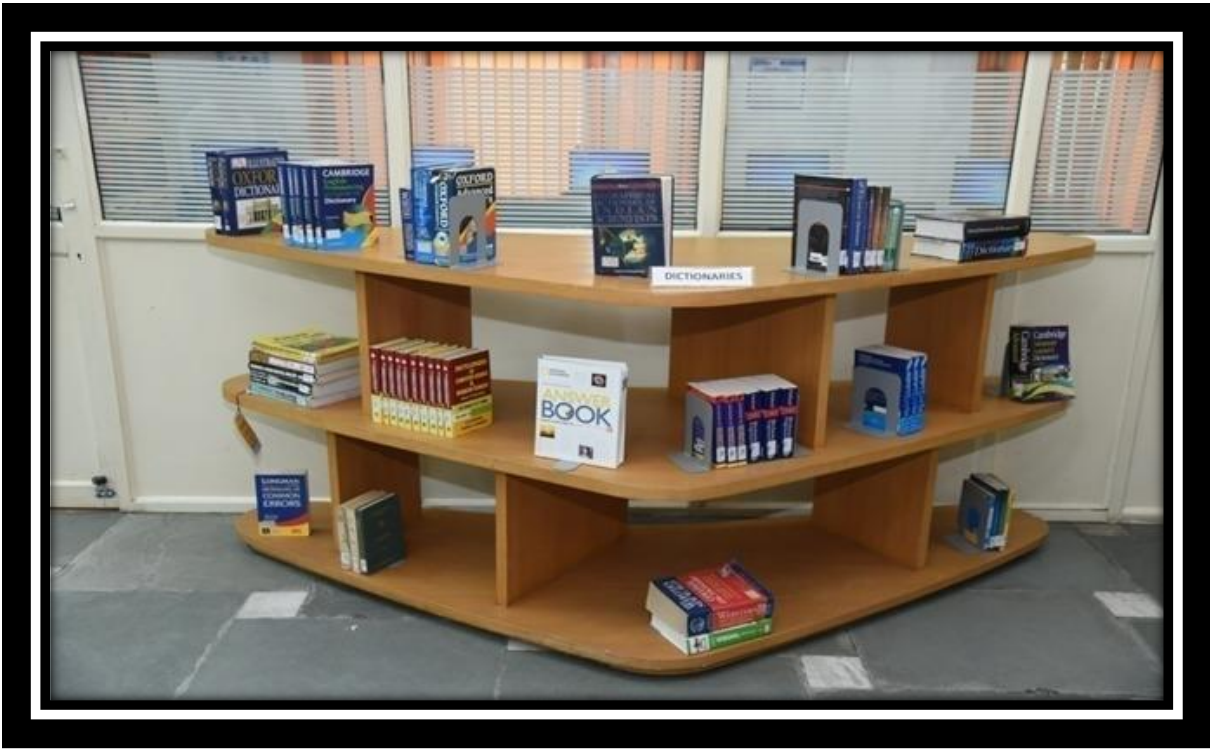
